We are excited that you will be a part of our Lakes Volleyball 4th Annual Volleyball Tournament held at Forest Lake Century Junior High.

Pool Play/Warm-ups

FYI: This tournament is shared between 12's and 17's. The 17's are beginning play earlier than the 12's due to the number of teams. There will be *one* round of play by the 17's on the 12's courts (Courts 1 & 2, in Gym A) before the 12's begin (approximately 9 a.m.). Play continues for the 17's with the second and subsequent rounds on Courts 3 & 4, in Gyms B & C.

There will be a coaches' meeting at 8:35 in Gym A, between Courts 1 & 2 (after completion of first round of play by 17's on those courts).

Pool play competition will begin at **9:00 a.m.** Officiating team should do the coin flip and start warm-ups at 8:45. There will be a 10 minute (4-4-2) warm up for each team's first match only. (If you are competing against a team that is playing for the first time in pool play, you will still have a 10-minute warm-up even if you have already competed.) A 5-minute (2-2-1) warm-up will follow for the remainder of competition. Two games to 25 points with no cap, win by 2. If needed, a 3rd game to 15 points with no cap, switch sides when the first team reaches 8 points.

Playoffs

Playoffs will follow immediately after pool play. Playoffs are single elimination, best of three to 25, no cap. Third game, if needed, to 15, no cap; switch sides at 8 points. Top 2 teams in each pool will be in the Gold bracket; bottom 2 will be in the Silver bracket. Playoff matches may start early.

Division breakdown and placement in playoffs will be decided by:

1) Win/Loss Overall (matches then games); 2) Head-to-Head; 3) Point Differential; 4) Coin Flip

First and Second Place teams in Gold bracket, and First team in Silver bracket will receive medals.

Officiating

All teams will be responsible for officiating matches. Any team late for an officiating assignment and/or competition will be penalized. These teams will lose a point for every minute they are late.

The first referee must be the coach (or an adult registered with USAV who has been to an officials' clinic). Coaches and players are required to attend an officials' clinic before officiating. The officiating team must provide a first referee, second referee, scorekeeper, scoreboard operator, and two line judges.

Food

The Food Court, located outside the gym in the cafeteria area, will be available all day, opening at 7:15 a.m. for players and fans. This is a fundraiser for our club so concessions and other merchandise will be available for purchase all day. No coolers or outside food allowed. Please - All food should stay in the cafeteria.
